- annual risk assessments - completed at the start of each season to ensure that the club's training and match facilities are safe and suitable for use
- accident report book – completed by first aiders in the event of an incident

Club Liability Insurance

Horfield Korfball Club is insured through its membership with the England Korfball Association. This insurance covered is renewed annually. The club is responsible for ensuring that any incidents that could lead to a claim are reported to the company underwriting the policy at the earliest opportunity.
