Code of Conduct for Adult Members

Horfield Korfball Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well-being of all its members, ensuring a positive and enjoyable experience for all. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, members of its committee and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others. Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with the club's chair person.

As a member of Horfield Korfball Club, you are expected to abide by the following code of practice.

All members will:

- play according to the rules of korfball set by the local, national and international regulatory bodies for korfball
- respect decisions made by officials, coaches and members of the committee
- members will address any disagreements appropriately through the captain, coach or chair of the committee accordingly
- behave in a respectful manner to other members of the club and sport
- treat other members of the club and sport equally, with respect and dignity
- respect the rights and worth of all members of the club and sport regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity
- cooperate with the clubs coaches and captains in matters of training and development as an individual, team and club, recognising the contributions they make as volunteers
- keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late
- wear suitable kit for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/captain.
- pay any fees for training or events promptly according to the club's payment policy
- members should not smoke, consume alcohol or drugs whilst on club training or match premises, or whilst representing the club
- bullying of any sort will not be tolerated by the club
